BRAZORIA COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 18

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 18 of Brazoria and Harris Counties, Texas, will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **Tuesday, February 25, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.**, at the **First United Methodist Church, 2314 N. Grand Blvd., Pearland, Brazoria County, Texas 77581**, a meeting place of the District outside the District's boundaries.

The meeting will be held for the purposes of considering and acting upon the following matters:

1. Consider comments from public;
2. Approve minutes of the meeting of January 28, 2020;

NOTICE: Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 18 ("District") is seeking to contract with Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P. ("PBFCM") for the collection of delinquent taxes for the tax years 2019 and prior. The District wishes to contract with PBFCM in order to achieve enhanced recovery of delinquent taxes in a cost effective and expeditious manner. There is a need for these services as the District is unable to perform delinquent tax collections due to budgetary constraints and lack of personnel. In addition, delinquent tax collection services are not provided by the District's general counsel. Delinquent tax collection services cannot be performed on an hourly basis as current law provides for collection of a penalty. PBFCM's fee structure is fair; it is a percentage set by the Texas Legislature and represents penalties borne by the delinquent account holders, not the District. PBFCM is an experienced firm with over 40 years of experience in collecting delinquent debts, with 12 offices, over 50 attorneys and 400 additional tenured employees. In addition, PBFCM has represented the District since 2000. For the foregoing reasons contracting with PBFCM is in the best interests of the District and its taxpayers.

3. Tax matters, including:
 - (a) adopt Resolution Implementing 20% Penalty and contracting with Delinquent Tax Attorney for the Collection of Delinquent Taxes;
 - (b) adopt Resolution Regarding Exemptions from Taxation;
4. Tax Assessor/Collector's report, including:
 - (a) authorizing payments from the Tax Account;
 - (b) Delinquent Tax Report;
5. Bookkeeper's report, including:
 - (a) discuss adding funds to budget;
 - (b) authorize payment of the District's bills;
6. Discuss repair of washout in outfall of Pine Hollow drainage channel;


